## REGULATION

on

### **Admission to Master's Degree Programme of Yerevan Haybusak University**

1. The citizens of the Republic of Armenia (RA) who are Diploma Specialists, hold Bachelor's or Master's Degree granted by RA state and accredited non-state higher education institutions, are eligible to be admitted to Master's Degree of Yerevan Haybusak University.

The admission to Master's degree (MA) of foreign citizens is made based on the agreement of the RA Ministry of Education and Science.

2. The MA education is organized on a paid basis. Tuition fee discounts can be granted to representatives of separate social groups (two-sided (maternal and paternal) orphans, children of perished freedom fighters, members of multi-member families, etc.)
3. For the conduction of MA admission the Admission Committee is compiled based on the Rector's order. The composition of the Admission Committee involves the Rector /President/, Vice-Rector for Educational Affairs /Vice-President/, Head of Educational-Methodical Department, Head of Department of MA Education, Deans of respective faculties.
4. Upon consideration of the faculty's opinion, the Admission Committee examines and discusses the lists of applicants proposed by the given faculty and conducts admission in accordance with specialties, taking into consideration the list of courses studied in their basic education. The following documents are required for the MA admission:
  - application to the Rector,
  - original and copied versions of diploma of Bachelor's Degree, Diploma Specialist, Master's Degree and respective supplement,
  - xerox of passport,
  - 4 photos (3x4).
5. The MA admission is organized in two phases.

5.1 The given faculty's graduates of the current academic year can enter the first phase if the sum grade point average (GPA) of their general academic performance of the previous study program is “excellent” and “good”. The first phase of admission is implemented based on submitted documents and GPA of subject courses registered in the supplement of diploma, by the decree of the Admission Committee. In case the average points are equal, the following additional criteria are taken into consideration:

- diploma with honor,
- grades of final attestation examinations,
- reports made in scientific conferences.

5.2 The following graduates are eligible for the second phase of competition-based admission:

- a) the given faculty's graduates of the current academic year whose sum GPA of academic performance of professional courses (majors) of the previous study program is “excellent” and “good”,
- b) other universities' graduates of the current academic year who meet the requirements set by the 5.1 and 5.2 a) provisions of the current Regulation,
- c) alumni of the previous years.

The second phase of admission is implemented based on the applicant's results of the interview of previous study program, by the decree of the Admission Committee.

In case the interview results are equal, the following additional criteria are taken into consideration:

- GPA of subjects registered in the supplement of diploma,
- grades of final attestation examinations,
- reports made in scientific conferences.

6. Based on decisions made by the Admission Committee, the Rector of the University enacts a decree on admitted applicants after full payment of tuition fees.
